



FBCC Minister of Students (Youth)

PRINCIPAL FUNCTION: The Minister of Students (Youth) is to lead the student ministry of the church to fulfill its mission faithfully, effectively, and lovingly. Work with the Pastor, staff, students, and their parents to develop, implement, and lead a ministry for students (6th grade through college.) He will serve as a member of the church council. The Christian growth of the students should be this person's primary concern.

REQUIREMENTS: A degree from an accredited college, university, or seminary, preferably in a related discipline, (e.g. Youth guidance, education, Christian Education, etc.) At least 3 years' experience in youth ministry leadership, 5 years preferred. We prefer our Minister of Students to be married and have a healthy relationship with his spouse.

ACCOUNTABILITY: The minister of students is accountable to the Pastor, Personnel Committee, and Church body.

GERNERAL EXPECATIONS:

- Must have a growing relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Be at the church for regular worship services and special services.
- Must support and speak positively about staff, church leaders and members of First Baptist Centerville.
- Maintain flexible working hours as determined by the needs of the ministry.
- Knowledgeable concerning relevant legal guidelines, laws, and ethical issues.
- Aligned with FBCC vision, goals, values, and policies.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work with youth Sunday School teachers and leaders to plan a program for leading youth to a knowledge of the plan of salvation and to discover and develop their spiritual gifts.
- Promote respect for authority, for parents and for each other.
- Meet and counsel students and their families as needed.
- Organize and lead a student outreach ministry that focuses on evangelism and discipleship.
- Establish and maintain routine communications with parents.

- Coordinate the planning of student activities with the minister of music in relation to youth choir and band.
- Create and maintain a safe and welcoming environment for guests, students, and their families.
- Responsible for all teaching materials and curriculum for student youth Sunday School, Sunday and Wednesday nights as well as special groups such as Student Leadership University (SLU), DNow, or retreats.
- Lead in both small and large group Bible studies.
- Recruit and train student youth Sunday School teachers and leaders.
- Verify all youth leaders have an up-to-date background check on file in the church office.
- Plan and budget for all youth events for the entire year.
- Plan and oversee any fundraising events that might be necessary.
- Participate in regular staff meetings, retreats, and conferences as directed.
- Assist other ministerial staff to develop annual church calendar.
- Lead in a long-range plan for the Student Youth Division.
- Encourage Sunday School teachers and leaders to participate in visitation of prospects and absentees in Student Youth Division.
- Visit hospitals and shut-ins on a weekly basis.
- Other duties as needed but not listed.
