We currently minister to a diverse group of kids and young adults from a variety of financial, social, cultural and scholastic backgrounds. This will be a dual role position, in that there will be another area of service and leadership in addition to the Student ministry. The primary focus of youth ministry at FBCC should be concentrated on discipleship with a blend of activities and events with the emphasis being focused on our middle, high school, and college age students. The student pastor would communicate clearly with all staff and in accord with, and accountable to, the Senior Pastor.

Ministry responsibilities include but are not limited to: ensuring the weekly planning and conducting of youth activities/events/programs, including weekly youth worship services on Sunday and Wednesday nights. The Pastor of Student Ministries, as a valuable member of the staff, will also contribute to the programs and plans for the entire church family. He will be expected to support the regular services of the church and encourage our students to do likewise.

FBCC is a doctrinally conservative SBC church. Our student pastor will have a strong love for our God as well as a deep love and respect for His Word. We use the Baptist Faith and Message (2000) as our doctrinal statement. Our student pastor and his family will be people of integrity who love God's church and desire to be a part of what God is doing at FBCC.
